Genesis 3 reveals to us:

- 1. The absurdity of sin
- 2. The disintegration of sin
- 3. The hope of restoration from sin

The great reversal of the created order:

 $\mathsf{God} \to \mathsf{Adam} \ \& \ \mathsf{Eve} \to \mathsf{Creation}$

VS.

Creation \rightarrow Adam & Eve \rightarrow God
